Welcome

Thank you for the warm welcome I have received from the school community. I have been very impressed with how the children have settled on their first day back and will be delighted to say hello to all our school families in person over the coming days and weeks.

I am very excited to be working alongside the highly motivated, capable staff at Kirkistown and wonderfully supportive governing body to educate the fantastic children of our school community. I would like to take this opportunity to extend my thanks to everyone who has supported Kirkistown Primary - we look forward to continuing to make you proud of your local school.

Contact Details

At the start of the new academic year you will receive a number of documents to be completed and returned to school. Chief among these are the contact details (including mobile numbers) and medical forms. It is vital that we have an up to date record of your contact details and knowledge of the medical needs for your child in the event of an emergency. Inhalers and epi-pens are required to be available in school at all times. Please check and note the expiry date on any such medicines before sending these into school.

Dropping Off and Picking Up

I am very conscious that Main Road can be very busy with traffic and would therefore politely ask families to consider walking to school, where this might be possible, while the weather is pleasant.

Children must be collected at the end of the school day from the main entrance by a responsible adult. Children in **P6** and **P7** may be allowed to walk home alone with written permission from parents / carers but will not be allowed to take younger siblings with them as we feel this places a lot of responsibility on young shoulders.

Registration



Classroom registers close at 9:05am with lessons beginning promptly after. Children arriving after 9:05am will be recorded as late and must sign in at the school office before proceeding to class. While we understand that it can take a day or two to get back into the term-time routine, arriving late disrupts learning and we very much appreciate your support in helping avoid this where humanly possible.

Please also note that final numbers for school dinners are required to be received by 9:30am. If your child arrives after this time, it may not be possible for them to receive a school meal. Please alert the school office in advance (eg- if your child is at an appointment) or as soon as possible if you would like your child to have a school meal but they won't be in school by 9:30am.

Medical Appointments

Where possible, we politely ask that appointments are made either side of the school day. Where it is necessary for your child to attend an appointment during the hours of school, we would ask for notice if at all possible.

Healthy Break and School Dinners

The cost for healthy break and school dinners this year is as follows:

Fruit / Toast – 20p per day (£8.80 for August, September and October) Milk - 21p per day (£9.24 for August, September and October) School Dinners - £2.60 per meal.

Payments should be sent to school **on Mondays** in a small pink envelope that can be obtained from the school office. If a child is absent or school is closed on Monday, payments should be sent on the next school day. Please make sure that names and classes are clearly marked on the envelope.

Healthy Break Volunteers

We are currently looking for volunteers to offer 30 minutes (10:00-10:30am) to assist in the preparation of the healthy break by cutting up fruit, preparing toast etc. This valuable service relies on the good will of the wider school community and we very much appreciate the support of our school community in helping us facilitate it. If you are regularly available between these times on any given day of the week, we would greatly appreciate your help. Please contact the school office if you can be of assistance.

Kid's Club

Our after-school Kid's Club will continue to run this year, facilitated by Ms Matthews. At £3.50 per hour and £2 per half hour, we believe it is good value for money and hope that it continues to be of service to the community. Additional children will continue to be charged at £2 per hour and £1 per half hour. The first session will be on Monday 03 September 2018.

In addition, we would warmly encourage families to send in any awards, certificates, trophies or badges that children have received outside of school to allow them to receive the recognition for the commitment that they have shown to earn these. Examples include: swimming certificates, sporting awards, acts of community spirit, Blue Peter badges, musical achievements, awards from Brownies, Cubs, Girl Guides etc. We firmly believe in celebrating the 'whole child' and value the support families give to allow their children to flourish in these areas.

Each class will also conduct a termly 'Class Assembly' where children will present aspects of their learning to their peers and friends of the school. Our Friday assemblies will begin shortly after **9:10am** and will be open to families who wish to celebrate the success of our children with us. If you would like to join us, please make your way to the assembly hall and help yourself to one of the seats available at the back of the hall. Assemblies should last approximately 15 minutes though class assemblies might take a little longer.

Nut Free School

All parents are asked to note that we have children in school who have allergies to nuts. Children with this condition could have a severe reaction if they come into contact with nuts, or nut related products. For some of these children a severe allergic reaction may be caused simply by touch or smell alone. Consequently, we are asking that no nuts or nut related products are brought into school for your child's break or packed lunch. Your support with this could prevent a serious medical emergency developing. I am sure you will appreciate the reasons for making this request and trust that you will give it your full co-operation.
