
# Every child a published writer!

# **Healthy Break Reminder**

The Public Health Agency recommend water and milk as the most suitable drinks for young children. Fruit juices, smoothies, sparkling water and drinks labelled 'no added sugar' or 'zero' are not recommended and are discouraged as part of our mid morning break.

Foods containing a lot of sugar and /or salt egcereal bars, pancakes, scones (plain and fruit), fruit bread, malt loaf, brioche, croissants and Danish pastries- are not recommended.

We want all our children to be healthy and well. We therefore encourage children to have a healthy morning break consisting of fruit, a vegetable snack or crackers.



# **Christmas Nativity**


