IMPORTANT DATES AND TIMES

Monday 24th and Tuesday 25th P7 ONLY- all children with no siblings arrive at 8:45 am and leave at 10:50am
- all children with siblings arrive 9 am and leave 11 am

From Wednesday 26th P6 & P7 - same times apply to non- siblings and siblings as above

From Tuesday 1st September P6 & P7 - all children with no siblings arrive at 8:45 am and leave at 1:45 pm
- all children with siblings arrive at 9 am and leave at 2 pm

From Monday 14th September P6 & P7 - all children with no siblings arrive at 8:45 am and leave at 2:45 pm
- all children with siblings arrive at 9 am and leave at 3pm

This timetable may change as and when directed by the Public Health Agency via the Education Authority.

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE ON MONDAY

Please ensure that you bring the following items, in a disposable bag, with you on Monday.

- Hand sanitiser- minimum of 70% alcohol
- Anti-bacterial wipes -minimum of 70% alcohol
- Pocket tissues

Also remember:

- No school bags to be brought in
- School uniform (labelled with name)
- Waterproof coat
- If you wish to bring a pencil case it will need to remain in school
- Ensure that ALL jewellery is left at home- including watches or Fitbits

ENTERING SCHOOL



You will enter the school through the main entrance and use the hand sanitiser provided.

OUR CLASSROOM



This is what our classroom looks like. You will each have a table to yourself and must face forward at all times.

Please aim to stay at a 2 metre distance from all adults and 1 metre from other children.

Windows will be open to ensure good ventilation.

WALKING THROUGH SCHOOL



Walking through the rest of the school will be limited. When doing so you must follow all the arrows and stay on the LEFT.

VISITING THE TOILET



When using the toilet facilities please ensure that you wash your hands before and after use.

BREAK TIME

Weather permitting, you will spend break time outside in the back playground.

Please ensure you have a waterproof coat and a snack.

Break time is from 10:40 am until 11 am.

Please DO NOT share your snack with ANY of your friends.

LUNCH TIME

You will be outside in the back playground whilst the younger children eat their lunch from 12 pm until 12:25pm in the dining hall.

At 12:25pm you will enter the dining hall and eat your lunch in a different area of the hall until 12:50pm.

HOME TIME

Over the next few weeks home times will differ. Please refer to the Important dates and times in slide 3 of this PowerPoint.

A.Q.E. PUPILS

Provision and support for those children who having been working hard towards the A.Q.E. Exam will start on Wednesday 2nd September in class.
